Shop Monitors assist the Shop Foreman in maintaining a safe working environment for all Woodchips Members. Among other responsibilities, Shop Monitors are an essential part of shop operations, provide the Shop Foreman with a "second pair of safety eyes," answer the shop phone, greet visitors, supervise daily shop administrative operations, and provide other support to Members. Monitors learn and become proficient in shop procedures, are exposed to woodworking tips and advanced techniques, meet other Woodchips Members, and learn new woodworking skills.

Woodchips rewards Monitors for their service to the Club by (1) granting access to the shop one "extra" day each week to work on personal projects, (2) annual invitation to a Monitors-only Appreciation Breakfast or other event, (3) annual invitation to join Foremen for a Foremen and Monitors-only Oktorberfest event. Monitors are also permitted to apply for upgrade to Foreman status.

Monitors are approved by the Woodchips Board, and serve at the pleasure of the Board. Woodworking experience and advanced woodworking skills are not required, but the member must have completed as a minimum, the Core Cluster classes #3 Drill Press/Bandsaw, #4 Jointer/Planer, #6 Table Saw and #6A Compound Miter Saw.
